



DOWNLOADABLE AUDIOBOOKS & EBOOKS AVAILABLE THROUGH NH CONSORTIUM

Check out an audio book or ebook twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week through the downloadable book program, OverDrive Media. The Walpole Library has joined a statewide consortium that offers titles from bestselling authors anytime through the New Hampshire Downloadable Audio Books Program. A digital audiobook or ebook can be enjoyed in many ways: on your personal computer or PDAs (Palm devices, Pocket PCs, Smartphones, etc.); burned to a CD or DVD; or transferred to a portable device such as an MP3 player, and now to iPods and iPhones when accessed through a Windows computer.

How it Works

Patrons can download up to three books a week for seven days. Books will automatically be disabled after seven days so you will want to listen to the book(s) or transfer the book(s) to your portable device or a CD or DVD, where approved, within that time frame. There are no renewals or early returns of books.

If you are a Mac user, you will only be able to use the MP3 audio books. If you are an iPod user and have access to a PC, you will be able to check out all of the MP3 titles and a majority of the Windows Media Audio titles. Look at the Digital Rights Information listed at the bottom of each audio book record and see if the transfer to an iPod device is permitted. Please note that while OverDrive Media Console will work on most versions of Microsoft Windows, most MP3 players will only work with Windows XP or Vista.

Go to the following web site: nh.lib.overdrive.com. A user tutorial is available by clicking on "download digital media GUIDED TOUR" to download an introduction to using audiobooks. The newest version of OverDrive Media Center (OMC), version 3.2, has many improvements, and is the only version supported, so please start by downloading the new free software. Just above the books you'll find a Required Software button.

Download Free Software – Overdrive Media Console for Audio Books

1. Click the OverDrive® Media Console link.
2. On the right side of the OverDrive window select either the Mac or Windows version and verify that your system meets the minimum requirements.
3. Click the OverDrive Media Console Download button and click Save File.
4. In the Downloads window double click ODMediaConsoleSetup.msi.
5. Click Run in the Internet Explorer – Security Warning window and follow the directions in the OverDrive Media Console Setup:
 - a. Click Next to start the installation wizard.
 - b. Click I Agree if you accept the license agreement then Next
 - c. Click Next to install the software in the default location
 - d. Click Next to start the installation
 - e. If you get a security window, click Yes to install the software.
 - f. When the installation is complete, click Close
6. Enjoy your downloadable audio books.

Download Free Software – Adobe Digital Editions for eBooks

1. Click the Adobe Digital Editions link.
2. Under Next Steps click Download Now. At this point you may be prompted to download Adobe Flash Player (follow the directions) or if nothing happens, click Installation TechNote (just below the Flash Player button).
3. Click Download then click Save File.
4. In the Downloads window double click Setup.exe (at the top of the list).
5. If you get a security warning window click Run button.
6. If you get a user account control window click Yes
7. Select where you want icons to run Adobe Digital Editions and click Next.
8. Click Install then Close.
9. Activate Digital Editions: Click I Agree then click Continue.
10. If you don't have an Adobe Account you'll need to get one – follow the wizard steps.
11. Enter your ID and password, and click Continue twice. Your Digital Editions is activated.
12. Enjoy downloadable eBooks.

Selecting and Downloading Audio Books or eBooks

Now that your computer is ready, you can download your audio book(s). Go to nh.lib.overdrive.com You need to Sign In (upper right corner of the web page). On the Sign In page, select "Walpole Town Library" in the first field. In the second field, enter your password and click the Sign In button. Remember, you must have a valid Walpole Town Library card to use OverDrive audio books. If you do not have a card, please visit the Library to obtain one. You will also need to call or visit the Library once for your personal password.

Select the book(s) you want to borrow and add them to your cart. You can have a maximum of three books at one time. When you are ready to download your selection(s), go to My Cart. Follow the instructions to confirm your selection(s) and download the book(s).

Using the OverDrive Media Console

Use the icon on your desktop to open the console. In the View All Media library, play the "Welcome to OverDrive Media Console" for an introduction to the user interface. OverDrive provides detailed instructions, and there is too much functionality to document here. If you have questions about using the OverDrive Media Console, there are several resources that provide step by step instructions:
